## Ofsted

We are expecting our first Ofsted inspection happen within the next 6 months.

## Covid- 19 Update

To safeguard our children and staff we:

- All children and staff must wash their hands when entering the nursery and regularly throughout the day.
- Please do not allow your child to bring in any toys from outside the nursery. The toys at nursery are cleaned and sterilised daily to create a sterile environment.
- Parents and carers must not enter the nursery unless asked to do so by a member of staff.
- If your child has a temperature which is 38c or more your child will not be allowed to enter the nursery and you must monitor the temperature at home. If the temperature does not go down within 24 hours the nursery must be contacted, and the child must Isolate.
